
Destination Moon, a co-creation between L'Epée 1839 and MB&F, is the quintessential torpedo-shaped rocket of childhood dreams. But look more closely and you will see that its minimalistic form is evocative rather than definitive.


Manufactured in Blue, Green, Silver and Black, 'Destination Moon' is now available in Red.

The eight-day movement follows the same basic architecture and design of an actual space rocket. The power is located on the bottom with the crown to wind the movement, the regulation is in the middle with the gear chain and the escapement, and the time and the time setting crown is located at the top.

In ode to childhood toys and fantasies, we had to create a Captain to command the spaceship — Neil, the smile-inducing, space-suited figurine forged in solid Silver is magnetically attached to the ladder connecting the crown to the movement. Neil is the astronaut piloting the Destination Moon to the distant universe of your office or display room.
